

COVID Safety Measures

- Safety is our top priority for our delegates, exhibitors and contractors.
- RTS is consistently working with suppliers, venues, contractors and local and state government to ensure that RTS 2021 is delivered in a safe and controlled environment, within COVID-19 government guidelines.
- We are working closely with Perth Convention & Exhibition Centre and state governments to ensure APPEA 2021 is delivered within all guidelines and restrictions.
- RTS 2021 will encourage a no contact policy of engagement for attendees on site, relating to all staff and attendees.
- QR code scanning is required of all attendees onsite
- Queue management and crowd control mechanisms are in place to ensure smooth and considered traffic flow.
- Attendees' movements will be monitored by COVID marshals.
- Cleaning and hygiene practices will be delivered to the highest standard including hand sanitiser stations being available to delegates throughout the conference venue.
- Regular announcements will remind delegates of appropriate COVID safe practices.
- Standing and digital signage will reinforce COVID safe practices to delegates throughout the venue.
- COVID marshals will maintain social distancing and encourage safe practices onsite.
- The showcase layout ensures appropriate physical distancing, minimising congestion and the chance of close contact
- In the event of a COVID-19 community transmission, there is a RTS Incident Management Team that will meet promptly to discuss the event climate in response to any escalating restrictions to reduce the spread of COVID-19 in WA or interstate
